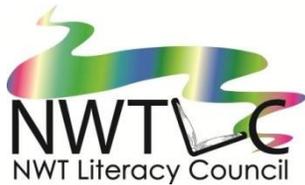


Celebrate Aboriginal Languages Month!
