Training will include:

What are Skills for Success?

An overview of Skills for Success and how to help youth develop their skills through programming that interests them.

Learning in the Kitchen

An interactive program using cooking to develop Skills for Success. Learn how to facilitate a program that helps youth learn to cook healthy meals, while having fun and learning Skills for Success.

Telling Our Stories

A technology-based, digital storytelling program. Learn how to lead youth in creating their own digital stories, while helping them to develop their computer use and other essential skills.

Youth Literacy Nights

A series of stand-alone activities that can be done at drop-in youth events Learn how to use short events to help youth develop Skills for Success.

Facilitation Skills

Learn and practice facilitation techniques to gain confidence in facilitating a program.

Evaluation Skills

Learn techniques for evaluating community projects, and understand the evaluation expectations for the Skill Builders for Youth project.

Program Planning

Learn how to plan, promote and track a project. Work with a partner to choose a project to do in your community, then begin to plan it. After the training, receive support from NWTLC staff to complete the planning.

Preparing for the training

- ✓ Consider which project you would like to do (Learning in the Kitchen, Telling our Stories, or Youth Literacy Nights)
- ✓ Think of a community group who could support the project. This group would need to:
 - Receive and handle funds
 - Report to NWTLC at the end of the project
 - Ideally provide administrative support, project space, and/or equipment required by the chosen projects
- ✓ Find potential community support for a youth literacy and essential skills project, for example:
 - Elders who will provide guidance
 - Library that will offer project space
 - School that can offer computer lab access

What does Skill Builders for Youth training cost?

This training is free of charge and includes travel costs for those coming from outside of Yellowknife, Ndilo and Dettah.

NWTLC will pay for:

- Airline tickets, car mileage (at a flat rate), bus/van tickets and taxis to/from the airport
- Per diems for all meals away from home except those served at the training
- Hotel room for the minimum number of nights for travel
- One item of luggage for airline travel

NWTLC will not pay for:

- Additional baggage fees after one item
- Additional nights in the hotel if you come to Yellowknife early or stay later
- Additional per diems if you come to Yellowknife early or stay later
- Additional hotel fees if you want to have others stay with you
- Extra hotel fees such as long-distance calls, any damage or cleaning fees
- Additional airline ticket costs if you want to travel on different dates and if the tickets are a different price
- Salary, overtime or participant honourariums
- Costs related to missed travel
